The class will be held at the Dakota Curling Club, which operates in the Burnsville Ice Center at 251 Civic Center Parkway in Burnsville.

### Directions from 35W:

Exit at Cty Road 42  
Turn left (east)  
about 1/2 block, then turn left again onto Nicollet  
about 3/4 mile, then look for a marquis listing  
Burnsville City offices and turn right

### Directions from 35E:

Exit at Cty Road 42  
Turn right (west)  
about 1/2 block, then turn right again onto Nicollet  
about 3/4 mile, then look for a marquis listing  
Burnsville City offices and turn right

There will be a \$15 fee for the class, which will be collected at the door.

Please plan to arrive at least 15 minutes early to complete your registration. The first portion of your class will be classroom instruction explaining the rules and tips of curling to new players and the second and third hour will be on-ice practice sweeping and throwing stones.

12:00 to 12:30 pm – Instruction in classroom  
12:30 to 1:00 pm – Observe curling games  
1:00 to 3:00 pm - On the ice practice

You should wear loose-fitting clothing such as sweatpants or warm-ups and warm outerwear. Please also bring with you a pair of CLEAN rubber soled shoes (such as tennis shoes) to wear on the ice. (These should not be the same shoes you walked in on.)

### ***You will learn all about the game including...***

- *What is all that sweeping about?*
- *The difference between a hack and a hog line.*
- *Why an end isn't necessarily "The End".*
- *Why it's desirable to throw rocks at the house.*
- *How easy it really is to slide a 42-pound rock down the ice.*
- *And finally, how you score in this sport*

All equipment needed for the class will be provided.
