I am writing this letter to invite you to the first tryouts for the US Deaf Women's National Volleyball Team.

Several weeks ago, I was selected as the head coach of the US Deaf Women's National Volleyball Team. And now, I am looking forward to step into a RED, WHITE, and BLUE volleyball program and to working with you closely.

The tryouts will be held at Texas School for the Deaf (TSD) in Austin from June 29 to July 1, 2007. The tryout fee is \$110 dollars. The fee will cover includes registration, USADSF liability coverage, breakfast meals, medical staffing, t-shirt and tryout expenses. You are required to have medical insurance coverage in order to participate in this event.

The international volleyball schedule is the 4th Pan American Deaf Games in Venezuela (August 2007), 1st World Volleyball Championships in Argentina (August 2008) and Summer Deaflympics in Taiwan (September 2009).
