In addition to being one of the most visible promoters of the annual 5K, Alex interviewed USADSF Hall of Fame inductee, Dr. Glenn Anderson and his son, Jamaal, a Child of Deaf Adults (CODA) and former pro football player as part of USADSF and Daily Moth's joint effort in coverage of Black History Month in February 2021.
